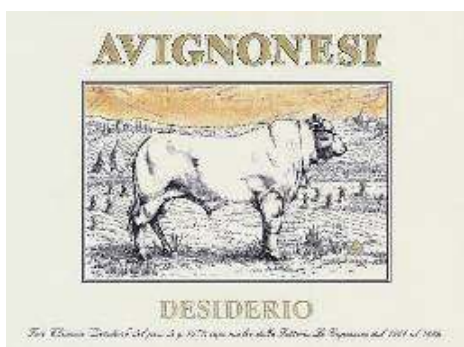


AVIGNONESI



Magnum Desiderio 1998

1998 is a monument of a vintage. Austerity and minerality are the key words to describe our Desiderio in this age-worthy year. Big structure and high acidity allows this wine to still retain its character, not fully showing its potential yet, but just hinting how it's going to evolve with further time in the cellar.

Reserve: € 90



3 litres Vino Nobile di Montepulciano Riserva 1988

This is quite a rare bottle, given the very feeble number of 3- litres bottles of this wine. 1988 is one of the best vintages in the last 30 years and this Riserva showcases tremendous depth of fruit, amazing earthy flavours typical of a maturing Sangiovese and evolving spice scents making the wine even more alluring.

Magnum 50&50 2004

2004 50&50 is still in its infancy. We all know the ageing potential of this wine, especially in great vintages like '04. At the moment we can expect a very reserved and shy wine, displaying seamless structure waiting to unfold its secrets. Alluring aromas of sandalwood, chocolate-dipped cherries and lots of black fruits are the main features of this evolving gentleman.

Vin Santo di Montepulciano 1997

The story around Avignonesi Vin Santo comes from our native “mother”, a family of yeasts which is indigenous of the estate dating back to over a hundred years. Malvasia, Trebbiano and Grechetto are the grapes involved in the creation of this jewel, which has benefitted from the great climatic conditions of this vintage, displaying a synergy of richness and elegance making it one of our best “réussites”.

Vin Santo di Montepulciano “Occhio di Pernice” 1993

Occhio di Pernice is the jewel of Avignonesi’s crown. Selected batches of Sangiovese are left to dry and then sealed into Caratellis for 10 years, makes it the highest and intense expression of Vin Santo. Occhio di Pernice 1993 has the breadth and the poise of a neo-classic masterpiece, defining once and for all the benchmark features of this unmissable “sensorial experience”.

3 litres Grifi 1988

Grifi is one of the wines that has helped to define Avignonesi’s image of excellence throughout its history being one of the first Super Tuscans in the Montepulciano/Cortona area. Nowadays the wine isn’t produced anymore and 1988 is definitely the best expression of this nectar to date. Still bursting with life and utter elegance it displays the royalty of the Sangiovese from Montepulciano, blended with the best batches of our Cabernet Sauvignon from Cortona. Only a few bottles are left in our cellar, becoming one of the rarest wines of our domain.
